1. DEFENITIONS

The following terms shall have the following meanings:

"Account" means an account required to access and/or use certain areas and features of our products and services;

"Personal Information/Data" means personal information that can be associated with an identified or identifiable person. Personal information does not include information that does not identify a specific user.

"Process" means any method or way that we handle Personal Information or sets of Personal Information, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, and consultation, disclosure by transmission, disseminating or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction of Personal Information.

2. SCOPE

This Privacy Notice applies to Personal Information that is Processed by Us in the course of our business, when you use our products and services and our website claimandget.com ("Our Site").

All individuals whose responsibilities include the Processing of Personal Information on our behalf are expected to protect Personal Information by adherence to this Privacy Notice.

3. WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

3.1. Information You Give Us Directly

User Account Creation: When you create a user Account, we collect your name, email address, date of birth, username, and password, security questions and answers. We may require you to provide us with additional information as you use our Services or Products.

Payment and financial information. We may collect your payment and billing information.

Your Communications with Us. We collect Personal Information from you such as email address, phone number, or mailing address when you request information about our Services or Products, register for our newsletter, request customer or technical support, or otherwise communicate with us.

Social Media Content. We may offer forums, blogs, or social media pages. Any content you provide on these channels will be considered "public" and is not subject to privacy protections.

3.2. Other Information We Collect When You Use Our Services and Products

3.2.1. Device Information. We may collect certain information automatically when you use the Services and Products. This information may include your Internet protocol (IP) address, mobile and other hardware or device identifiers, browser information (including your browser type and the language you prefer), user settings, cookie identifiers, mobile carrier, mobile advertising and other unique identifiers, location information, Internet service provider, pages that you visit before, during and after using the Services, information about the links you click, and other information about how you use the Services. Information we collect may be associated with accounts and other devices.

In addition, we may automatically collect data regarding your use of our Services and Products, such as the types of content you interact with and the frequency and duration of your activities.

3.2.2. Cookies, similar technologies (pixel tags/web beacons), Analytics Information, and Interest-Based Advertising technologies.

We and third parties that provide content, advertising, or other functionality on the Services or Products, may use cookies, pixel tags, local storage, and other technologies ("Technologies") to automatically collect information through the Services and Products. Technologies are essentially small data files placed on your computer, tablet, mobile phone, or other devices that allow us and our partners to record certain pieces of information whenever you visit or interact with our Services.

Cookies. Cookies are small text files stored on your Internet browser. Most browsers allow you to block and delete cookies.

Pixel Tags/Web Beacons. A pixel tag (also known as a web beacon) is a piece of code embedded in the Services that collects information about users' engagement on that web page. The use of a pixel allows us to record, for example, that a user has visited a particular web page or clicked on a particular advertisement.

3.2.3. Analytics.

We may use Google Analytics and other service providers to collect information regarding visitor behaviour and visitor demographics on our Services or Products. 3.3. Information from Other Sources

3.3.1. We may receive information about you from other sources, including through third party services and organisations to supplement or verify information provided by you. This supplemental information allows us to verify information that you have provided to us and to enhance our ability to provide you with Products and Services.

4. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We use your information for a variety of business purposes, including to:

4.1. Operate our business, fulfil our contract with you and provide you with our Services and **Products**, such as:

- Managing your information and Accounts;
- Responding to your questions, comments, and other requests;
- Providing access to certain areas, functionalities, and features of our Services and Products;
- Communicating with you about your Account, activities on our Services and Products, and policy changes;
- Processing your financial information and other payment methods;
- Processing applications and transactions; and
- Answering your requests for customer or technical support.

4.2. Analyse and improve our Services and Products, such as:

- Verifying your identity and preventing fraud;
- Detecting bugs or other software issues;
- Preventing potentially prohibited or illegal activities;
- Ensuring internal quality control;
- Measuring interest and engagement in our Services and Products;
- Conducting research and development;
- Developing new products and services;
- Enforcing our Terms of Service; and
- To comply with our legal obligations, protect your vital interest, or as may be required for the public good.

4.3. Personalize our communications with you, including:

- Providing you with customised materials about offers, Services and Products that may be of interest, including new Products or Services; and
- Other purposes you consent to, are notified of, or are disclosed when you provide Personal Information.

You may contact us at any time to opt out of the use of your Personal Information for marketing purposes, as described below.

- **4.4. Automate profiling.** We may use technologies considered automated decision making or profiling. We will not make automated decisions about you that would significantly affect you, unless such a decision is necessary as part of a contract we have with you, we have your consent, or we are required by law to use such technology.
- **4.5. Use De-identified and Aggregated Information**. We may use Personal Information and other data about you to create de-identified and aggregated information.
- **4.6. Automatic Collection Technologies**. We, as well as third parties that provide content, advertising, or other functionality on the Services and Products, may use cookies, pixel tags, local storage, and other technologies to automatically collect information through the Services or Products.

5. HOW WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We do not share your Personal Information with third parties for their own use without your consent, unless it is either required by law or we determine that disclosure is reasonably necessary to enforce our rights or to protect us or third parties.

We may share your Personal Information with the following categories of third parties:

Service Providers. We may share any Personal Information we collect about you with our third-party service providers. The categories of service providers (processors) include: IT and related services; information and services; payment processors; customer service providers; and vendors to support the provision of the Services and Products.

Business Partners. We may provide personal information to business partners with whom we jointly offer products or services. In such cases, our business partner's name will appear along with ours.

Affiliates: We may share personal information with our affiliated companies.

Advertising Partners. Through our Services, we may allow third party advertising partners to set Technologies and other tracking tools to collect information regarding your activities and your device (e.g., your IP address, mobile identifiers, page(s) visited, location, time of day).

Disclosures to Protect Us or Others. We may access, preserve, and disclose any information we store associated with you to external parties if we, in good faith, believe doing so is required or appropriate to: comply with law enforcement or national security requests and legal process, such as a court order or subpoena; protect your, our or others' rights, property, or safety; enforce our

policies or contracts; collect amounts owed to us; or assist with an investigation or prosecution of suspected or actual illegal activity.

Disclosure in the Event of Merger, Sale, or Other Asset Transfers. If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, financing due diligence, reorganisation, bankruptcy, receivership, purchase or sale of assets, or transition of service to another provider, then your information may be sold or transferred as part of such a transaction, as permitted by law and/or contract.

International Data Transfers. You agree that all information processed by us may be transferred, processed, and stored anywhere in the world, and you authorise Us to transfer your Personal Information across national border and to other countries. The privacy protections and rights of authorities to access your Personal Information in these countries may not be equivalent to those in your country. We have taken appropriate safeguards to require that your Personal Information will remain protected and require our third-party service providers and partners to have appropriate safeguards as well.

6. YOUR CHOICES

6.1. General

Under the law of some jurisdictions, you may have certain choices about your Personal Information. Where you have consented to the processing of your personal information, you may withdraw that consent at any time and prevent further processing by contacting us as described below.

6.2. Email Communications

You may choose to opt-out of receiving certain email communications by following the instructions in the email to unsubscribe. However, we will continue to send transaction-related emails regarding products or services you have requested.

We process requests to be placed on do-not-mail lists as required by applicable law.

6.3. "Do Not Track"

Do Not Track ("DNT") is a privacy preference that users can set in certain web browsers. Please note that we do not respond to or honour DNT signals or similar mechanisms transmitted by web browsers.

6.4. Cookies and Interest-Based Advertising

You may stop or restrict the placement of Technologies on your device or remove them by adjusting your preferences as your browser or device permits. This means we cannot guarantee the security of your Personal Information and do not assume any responsibility for the unauthorised use or access to your Personal Information under out control.

9. CHILDREN'S INFORMATION

The Services are not directed to children under 18 (or other age as required by local law), and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children. If you learn that your child has provided us with Personal Information without your consent, you may contact us as set forth below. If we learn that we have collected any Personal Information in violation of applicable law, we will promptly take steps to delete such information and terminate the child's account.

10. YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS

EEA (European Economic Area) rights
